PwrSmart® v. 4.0.1

System Requirements for PwrSmart 4.0.1

The PwrSmart 4.0.1 maintenance release addresses an issue with computers' power-off events. In certain circumstances, the PwrSmart client would log overlapping power-off events for a computer, causing the computer's *Actual Hours Spent in Low Power* value (found on the Savings Profile tab) to be inflated. PwrSmart's reports could also show inaccurate data for the affected computers.

New Boundary Technologies recommends that you upgrade your PwrSmart installation to version 4.0.1, and that you also upgrade the clients to this version. Any new or upgraded clients will not exhibit the issue. Existing clients that are not upgraded will be prevented by the PwrSmart 4.0.1 Server from storing overlapping power-off events. However, leaving the PwrSmart clients at the older version could affect overall accuracy of your PrwSmart reports.

Customer-Requested Product Enhancements in PwrSmart 4.0.1

- 1. The AD Folder field is now available through More Fields when creating some computer-related reports.
- 2. The Operating System field is now available through More Fields on the Managed tab.
- 3. Windows 7, 8, 8.1 and Windows Server 2012 and 2012 R2 are now available when creating OS-related PwrGroups in the Console.
- 4. Microsoft SQL Server 2014 and 2014 Express are now supported platforms for installing PwrSmart's channel database.
